Potassium/Sodium Bromide:

This drug is a salt solution that quiets the nerves in the brain on a cellular level and thereby prevents seizures.

It can cause short term sedation, especially at the initial “loading” dose. You might notice increased thirst, increased appetite, depressed appetite or vomiting- at least initially. Let me know if that happens.

If you miss a daily dose, just give it when you remember. Do not double the dose the next day, as it can cause stomach upset.

You are going to give a higher dose (loading) for the first 5 days and then a maintenance dose. Do not stop it without calling me.
